Roy West

He died on the 4th February 2018 Aged 84years

He was a well-known athletics starter in the North East of England. He retired from the sport in 2012.

Roy a former police officer and athletics correspondent had started more than 300 international meetings around the world in a career spanning 60 years.

In that time Roy had overseen events including two European Championships and the Barcelona Olympics in 1992.

He was also the driving force behind the building of the Middlesbrough Clairville Stadium in the 1960's.

He served on the Board of the British Amateur Athletics Association and was a past President of the Northern Counties AAA (the forerunner to Northern Athletics).
